Complementing our partnership with Sinotrans, SILA is also a member of the global project cargo and heavy lift specialist group Project Cargo Network.

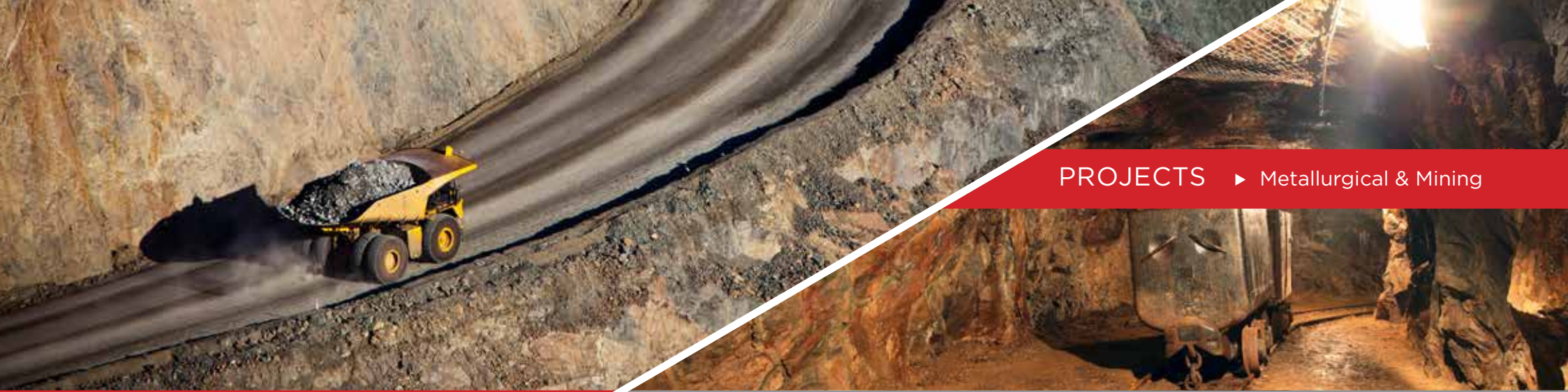

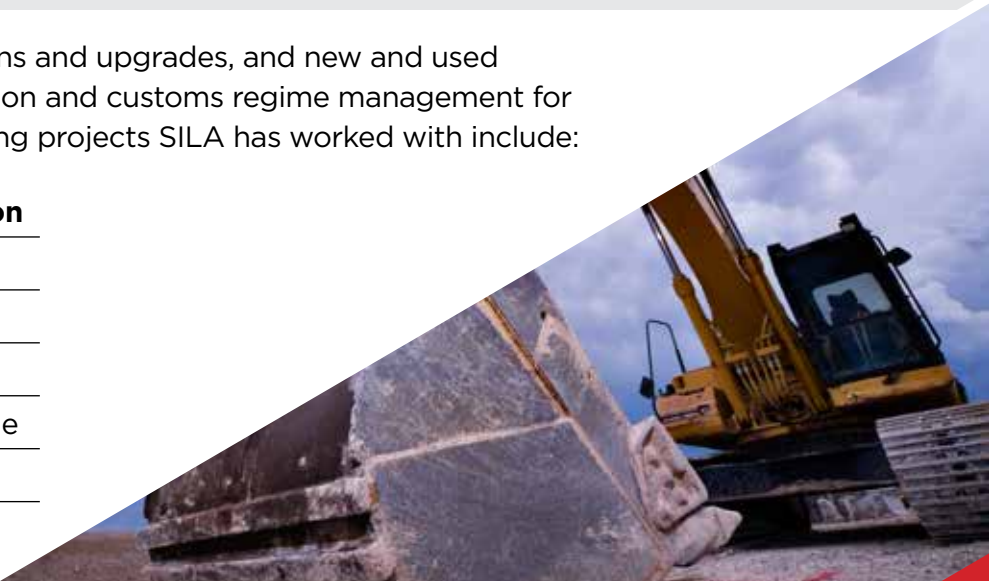
